2. to evaluate the condition of the victims.
3. to give first aid.
4. to rescue animals from emergencies and disasters.
5. to use security measures for oneself, people and animals rescue.
6. to use fire engines and equipments.
7. to use water sources for firefighting.
8. to use extinguishing materials when firefighting.
9. to use safety measures.
10. to work the explanatory work in the society in the field of fire prevention.
11. to perform destruction work of vehicles during traffic accidents.
12. to use rescue enginery and equipment.
13. to work in the place of traffic accident.
14. to use safety measures in the event of traffic accident.
15. to use safety measures in the event of chemical and ecological accidents.
16. to work in the place of chemical incident.
17. to work in the area polluted by radioactive substances.
18. to work in the event of ecological accident.
19. to use the elimination equipment for chemical and ecological accidents.

The activities of the person who finishes Firefighter-rescuer training programme are the following: rescue of people and animals, firefighting, elimination of traffic, chemical and ecological accidents.
