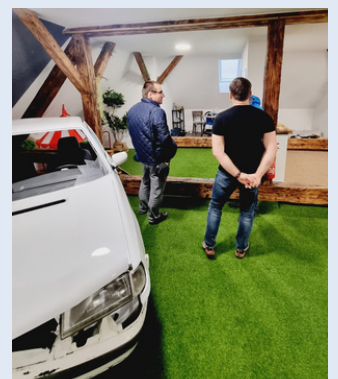
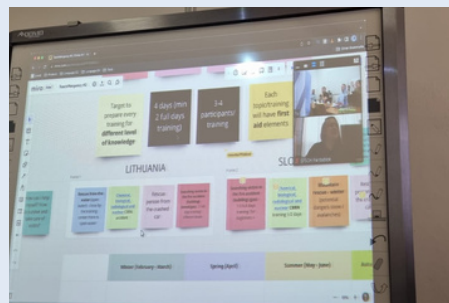
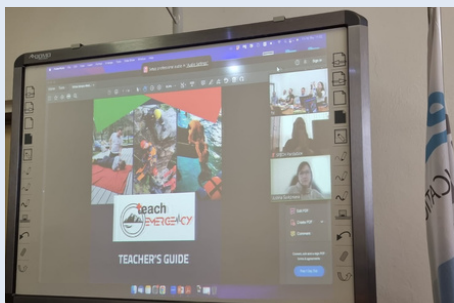


STAFF TRAINING - LEARNERS' BLENDED MOBILITY

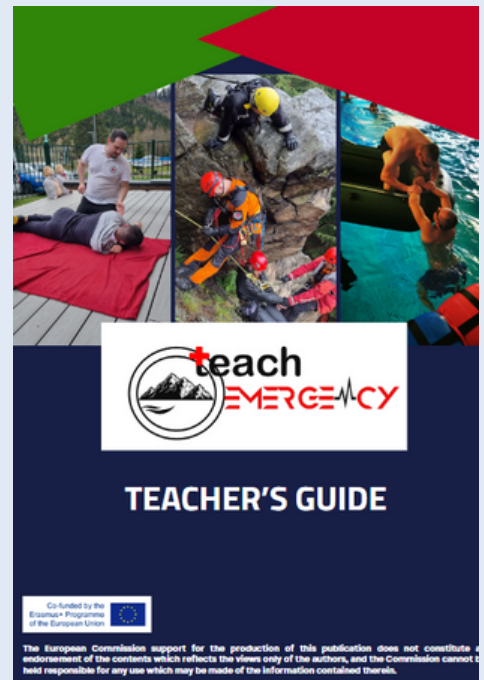
TEACHERS GUIDE

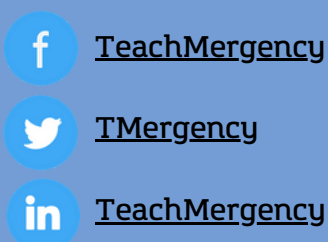
After the end of the project, Teachers guide with gathered good practice examples and produced educational videos will be available on the website, social media channels (e.g. YouTube).
